4 Refund:

(i) Application fee is neither refundable nor transferable except in rare cases where:-

(a) A student's application for student visa is rejected by the Immigration of Ghana.

(b) A student is unsuccessful in the interview process and medical examination as part of the enrollment procedure for Medical and Health Science programmes. In such circumstances, CROWN will refund the Application fee paid.

(ii) Paid Semester/term fees are non-refundable once the semester commences except in circumstances set out below:-

(a) If a student is offered and accepts a conditional offer of admission into the programme based on forecast results but fails to meet entry requirements is required to withdraw/discontinue the programme due to his/her official results not meeting entry requirements. The student will be eligible for a pro-rated refund of all fees paid (except for the Application and Registration fee). The pro-rated refund will be computed based on the number of weeks that has elapsed from the date of commencement of the semester to the date of the student's official result notification to the Head of Programme and proportionate to the total number of weeks of the relevant semester. Refundable deposits will be refunded less any sums due to CROWN, if any.

(iii) All refunds whether of fees, deposits or any other payments shall be free of interest and shall be subject to the right of set-off by CROWN against any fees or whatsoever payments due and owing to CROWN.

(iv) All claims for refund of any moneys (whether fees, deposits or any other payments) shall be made within 3 (three) months from the date the particular student ceases to be student of CROWN or is informed of his status in 4(i), and must be requested in writing for such refund to the Registrar.

5 No refund:

There shall be no refund (save and except refundable deposits) if a student is expelled from CROWN due to academic misconduct or disciplinary behaviour.

6 CROWN reserves the right to review the status of the student and take the necessary actions if payment is not received by the end of week 4 (four) of the semester. Such action may include barring the student from classes and facilities or suspension/termination of the student's enrolment/withdrawal of admission offer.

7 CROWN reserves the right to use a student's personal information in order to carry out its responsibilities in the student's personal and/or academic interest. The scope of usage of this information may include the publishing of examination results, the awarding of a prize of scholarship or engaging in any relevant mode of communication with the student.
